PILOT USE OF AN ASSISTIVE HEARING DEVICE WITH PATIENTS WHO HAVE A HEARING IMPAIRMENT.

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PROJECT'S AIM

To improve communication with patients who have hearing impairment at one of our care of the Elderly Wards - through the use of an assisted hearing device.



HOW THE PROJECT CAME ABOUT?

- Conversations and Observations Staff and Patients
- **71.1% over 70 years old some degree of hearing loss -** (Facts/Figures on hearing loss, deafness and tinnitus; action on hearing loss factsheet, April 2016).
- Literature Search
- Equality Act 2010
- Ad hoc use of a hearing aid device.



PLANNING

- Meetings with Senior Staff
- Meetings with Ward base Staff
- Paper Survey with MDT
- Consulted with Audiology Department (Crescendo 50)
- Caldicott and Ethical Approval
- Baseline Data 3 short/simple questions.



Crescendo 50/60 Hearing Aid





IMPLEMENTING THE PROJECT

- Provided a device on the Ward
- Ensured staff knew how and when to use it (demonstration)
- Easy accessibility Communication Box
- Capturing usage 3 simple/short questions
- Visible presence by Project Leaders/early stage
- PDSA Cycles x 3
- Project Duration 12 weeks
- PS: Not a substitute for hearing aids.



IMPACT/RESULTS – PATIENTS/STAFF

A. PATIENTS/RELATIVES -100% who provided feedback:

- Device easy to use and improved communication
- Found it helpful
- Some Families impressed at the difference the device made to communication - took details of the device/to buy it for home use.



IMPACT/RESULTS – PATIENTS/STAFF

B. STAFF

- 100% who provided feedback easy to use
- 75 % reported improved communication
- Ward Manager "Useful and always positive feedback"
- Occupational Therapist "Able to take a full history/involvement of the patient"
- Care of the Elderly Consultant "Questions about a patient's capacity cognitively intact".



WHAT HAS HAPPENDED SINCE - WHAT'S NEXT?

- Additional device purchased by the Ward
- Patient Experience Team one for each staff positive implications
- Other Departments in the Trust
- Presentation to Senior Nurses Forum
- Published in the BMJ Dr Elizabeth Wood (it was published at an early stage – limited information).
