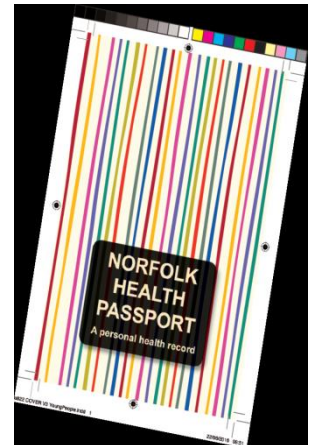

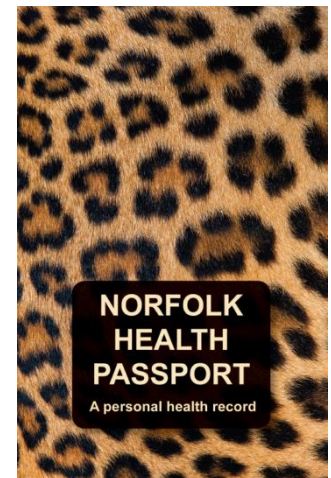
What we did

 - Graphic Designer – Me & The Dog



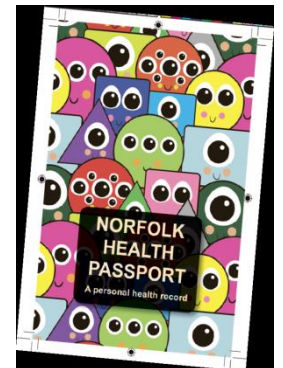
How we designed the passports

 - Printed and launched on XXXX

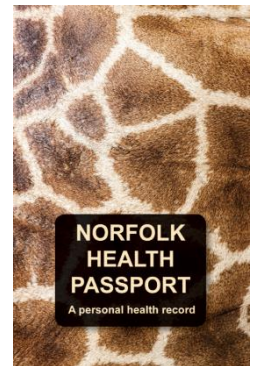


How we are promoting the passport
