Setting the scene

Back in 2019 we had a merge of Maternity Services across South Tyneside and Sunderland followed by COVID which yielded some new challenges.

This had a huge impact on our community midwifery team and the services we provided to the women of South Tyneside. There was instability and low moral within the team, which impacted on long-term sickness and poor team dynamics.

The compassion and commitment of staff were effected, many of whom chose Midwifery as a vocation and not just a job.

The challenges

- Poor communication
- Poor team working/lone working
- No team cohesion
- High sickness and low moral
- Patient complaints
- Poor patient experience
- Lack of training options
- Poor training compliance



What we did



- A change of base/Office
- Investment in the team
- Acknowledging and reimbursing staff for time worked above their contracted hours
- Invested in our Maternity Support Workers, offering training and acknowledging their role as part of the wider Midwifery team
- Recruitment of community admin assistant
- Improved team communication
- Re-introduced face to face bookings
- Midwife buddy system resulting in increased continuity for women
- Daily team huddle introduced to check in on staff wellbeing
- · Monthly team social event

Where we are now

- We are now achieving 100% face to face bookings, ensuring we are offering a quality service
- We are now 100% compliant with CO Monitoring, as part of Saving Babies Lives, reducing the risk of women experiencing premature birth and still births
- More cohesive team working together and supporting each other
- Recognition from our service users with positive feedback
- Improved sickness absence rates

She listens to me and takes my choices seriously. I'm never forced or advised to make certain decisions.
