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#### FiCare, what is it?

Family Integrated Care (FICare) is a model of neonatal care which promotes a culture of partnership between families and staff. The FICare model enables and empowers parents to become confident, knowledgeable and independent primary caregivers.

We worked closely with the north west neonatal operational delivery network to meet their accreditation criteria.

In July 2023 were assessed successfully accredited as green.

- Started 2019 launch day 1st July

- 7 staff attended network FiCare study days
- 1 staff presented Warrington's story at two of the network study days
- In house study day organised for all staff medical and nursing team, this included a member of staff from the Cheshire and Mersey perinatal mental health team, workshops for crib sheet use, network educator to present about the brain.




#### Tell us tags

Can see what teaching they have had.





 Mini cotside crib sheets made by Amy make teaching accessible for everyone






- Our nurse Emma made gestation cards

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The Padlet is a virtual platform where we share information with our families, from teaching aids to feeding guidance



- Koala are also offering support for our peer supporters






#### **SAM** scheme
