The Hair Loss Wigs & Tricology Service



The Hair Loss Wigs & Tricology Service is the result of sustained efforts led by Dr Rose Thompson, (now deceased) and other members of the *Sista's Against Cancer Support Group*, in Nottingham (two of whom also passed away, during the past year).

The vital need for this service was identified through the shared experience of the emotional trauma associated with hair loss (alopecia) due to chemotherapy treatment. The BAME (Black, Asian, and Minority Ethnic) Shared Governance Council, therefore, recognised the need for providing appropriate wigs for all cancer patients affected by alopecia.

This service offers an intensive range of healthy hair and scalp treatment therapies and a wide selection of healthy hair products including:

- Wigs, headwear, and healthy hair products.
- Hair loss consultation, clinical diagnosis of scalp problems, and
- Hair loss treatment plans.

There is a free drop-in clinic provided by a Tricologist with 20 years' experience, twice a month. These are held at QMC and City Hospital on Tuesdays, 10:00 am – 12:00 pm.
