









The Solution


How We Are Breaking Down Communication Barriers




- Trusted: Clinically validated content in 50+ languages and formats, including BSL, Easy Read and Read Aloud

- Proven: Using CardMedic increased patient understanding of healthcare staff from 67% to 95%, boosting confidence by 28%




